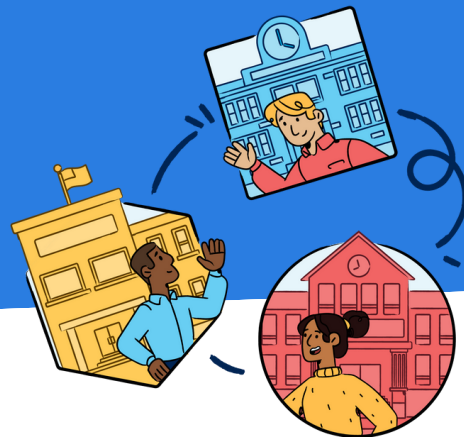




Principal Fellowship



What is the Principal Fellowship?

As we dare to reimagine education, leaning into meaningful systemic change must be a priority. The Real World Learning Principal Fellowship is a professional learning opportunity to grow your leadership capacity and create meaningful, lasting change in your school. The fellowship is a chance to use a community of practice framework to analyze and leverage data, use change management strategies and increase student agency.

Through virtual and in-person collaboration, this fellowship will help you maximize your network and strengthen the leadership within your school community to help you reach the goal of 100% market value asset attainment for your students.

Sustainable School Change Requires Support.

A change focused mindset combines creating a sense of urgency, coalition building, forming and communicating a clear vision, empowering teams to take bold action, strategizing around opportunities and continuously iterating to refine processes. As you and your team build capacity to enact sustainable change, the school culture will shift and both students and teachers will understand the value of real world learning.

Session Details

The fellowship will be personalized to meet the unique needs of each high school. We'll kick off in September 2023 and will consist of numerous opportunities to connect, grow and design. There will be 4 in-person fellowship days estimated to be 9:00-1:30pm, and up to 4 virtual 2 hour sessions. We'll also plan additional in-person and virtual optional events based on the needs of participants and your network. You'll also be supported by tailored coaching and resources between sessions. You can estimate 5 hours monthly outside of the session times for working on your plan within your school community and with the Getting Smart team.
